



The Transfiguration of Christ by Rafael—St. Peter's Basilica, Rome


Newscast Media HOUSTON, Texas—During the holiday season, most conversations tend to gravitate toward spiritual or religious-related topics. One such conversation I found myself in the middle of, had to do with the "morning star" and who this star refers to. Luciferians believe Lucifer is the morning star and that one day he will overthrow God and rule the world.

Luciferians also indoctrinate people that satan is Jesus Christ. Oddly enough, these same Luciferians swear that they are not satanists, which is oxymoronic. Satan is the name of Lucifer in his fallen state. Before Lucifer was kicked out of heaven, he was the most powerful cherub and was greater than all the other nine orders of angels. After his failed attempt to become like God, he was reduced to an unemployed cherub by the name of satan, whose mission has been to create counterfeit versions of God's glory.

Because Luciferians have the propensity to distort and manipulate the Holy Scriptures for their ulterior motives, I thought I would write an essay teaching and giving insightful information to my readers, about the controversial and misunderstood subject of the morning star. I will use the word satanists and Luciferians interchangeably because they are the same group of people. 
To give my readers a background of the ranking of celestial beings, I will list the nine orders of angelic beings starting with the highest in the celestial hierarchy. They are: **(i)** Seraphim **(ii)** Cherubim **(iii)** Thrones **(iv)** Dominions **(v)** Virtues **(vi)** Powers **(vii)** Principalities **(viii)** Archangels and **(ix)** Angels.

On a ride to the airport, the topic of the morning star came up, and the individual has convinced himself, that satan is Jesus Christ. He bases this on a falsely-translated version of the bible in the book of Isaiah's fourteenth chapter, verse twelve. The King James version has the correct translation and refers to Lucifer as **"shining star, son of the morning"**. See below:



The King James Version KJV and the New Living Translation NLT, correctly translate the text referring to satan as "son of the morning", not morning star.

However, the New International Translation NIV, whether intentional or unintentional, uses word-play and refers to Lucifer as "morning star, son of the dawn", thus attempting to equate satan to Jesus. This verse is what satanists and Luciferians use, to convince others that satan is the same as Jesus Christ. See below:




As you can see, this recent translation inaccurately refers to Lucifer as "morning star" while earlier translations use "son of the morning". This is how Luciferians attempt to deceive people that satan and Jesus are the same, yet it is all a disinformation campaign.

Nevertheless, for this to be true, the phrase "morning star" would have to be used exclusively to refer to satan, in other words, there would have to be only one "morning star" and not many others. We know that there are several other morning stars mentioned in the Holy Scriptures as we can see in the book of Job's thirty eighth chapter in the seventh verse that says: *"The morning stars sang together, and all the sons of God shouted for joy."*

We now know since there are several other morning stars, even if we were to take the falsely-translated NIV at its word, calling Lucifer the morning star. Let's take a look at the several other morning stars other than satan whom the NIV attributes this title.

As we saw previously, there are other "morning stars" that are mentioned in in the book of Job's thirty eighth chapter in the seventh verse that says: *"The **morning stars** sang together, and all the **sons of God** shouted for joy."* -**Original KJV.**

The New Living Translation and many other versions replace the word "**sons of God**" with "**angels**" as shown below:




The seventh verse talks about morning star(s) which is plural, signifying a host of other celestial beings that carry that title. The sons of God are the powers and principalities. They are part of the celestial order of the angelic beings. (See the celestial order of angels in Part I).

On a side note, the "sons of God" are different from angels—these are part of the celestial hierarchy and are "powers and principalities" from where we get the word prince. The princes and powers are also mentioned in Genesis chapter 6: "*And it came to pass, when men began to multiply on the face of the earth, and daughters were born unto them, That the sons of God saw the daughters of men that they were fair; and they took them wives of all which they chose.*"

This clearly shows that there is a distinction between angels (fallen or unfallen) and **sons of God**, because sons of God have reproductive organs and can reproduce, while angels cannot. It is also evident that Satan (the unemployed cherub) is different from the sons of God as demonstrated in the book of Job's first chapter: "*Now there was a day when the **sons of God** came to present themselves before the LORD, **and Satan** came also among them.*"

To conclude the argument about the morning star, and to expose the deception that

Luciferians are using to mislead people, Jesus Christ perhaps foresaw this and made a very clear distinction in the way he described Himself in Revelation's twenty-second chapter the sixteenth verse: **"I am the Root and the Offspring of David, and the bright Morning Star."** The operative word is **bright**. See text below:



Remember, Lucifer and his human slaves always counterfeit God's glory. (a) Jesus is the Lion of Judah who will usher in a peaceful kingdom, Lucifer is the roaming lion seeking whom he may devour. (b) Jesus is the Lamb who takes away the sins of the world, while we have been warned that satan (his false prophets) come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravenous wolves. (c) While satan claims to be the morning star according to Luciferians, Jesus Christ is the "Bright" Morning Star.

What Christ was doing was, he was saying, there are several morning stars (as we saw in scripture), but He is the "Bright Star" that outshines all other morning stars. His brightness is self-sustaining, while all the other morning stars depend on Jesus Christ to sustain themselves. The only person referred to as the "Bright Morning Star" is Jesus Christ, something Luciferians cleverly avoid mentioning, because it will show that their alleged "morning star" is inferior to the "Bright One"—and in actuality satan is not even referred to as a morning star, but "son of the morning."

How do you know someone is a Luciferian? Whenever you hear an individual claim that **satan = Jesus Christ**, you know you are dealing with a satanist who sold his or her soul to the devil. Such a demonized slave is a heretic and simply doing the bidding of his or her split-hoofed master—Lucifer himself.
